ABOUT REALITY LA

Reality LA is a gospel-centered church in the heart of Los Angeles. The overarching vision of the church is to seek the spiritual, relational, and cultural renewal of our city through the gospel of Jesus Christ. The church gathers on Sundays in Hollywood to re-center our lives on Jesus through the preaching of the word, corporate worship, and prayer. Throughout the week, people follow Christ together in one of the sixty community groups spread throughout the city. The church also offers classes and trainings to develop followers of Jesus holistically (theology, emotional health, finances, parenting, etc). With a deep calling to the lost and the broken, Reality LA aims to share the gospel and show the mercy and justice of God. Monday through Friday, the church serves meals to the poor and homeless community in Hollywood (totaling 1,000 meals per week). Reality LA is deeply biblical and theological, while committed to contextualizing the message and mission of Christ in the heart of one of the world's most broken and influential cities. At the end of the day, however, the people of Reality LA are not about themselves, they care about the name of Jesus being exalted in the City of Angels.

VISION

Seeking the renewal of our city through the gospel of Jesus Christ. The Bible tells the story of God reconciling his people and renewing his creation through the life, death, and resurrection of Jesus, and Reality LA longs to see this grand vision realized in Los Angeles.

MISSION

Making disciples of Jesus who love God, one another, and our city. Within the broader vision of God renewing his creation, the church's mission is to make disciples of Jesus. As a redeemed community grounded in Scripture, Reality LA does everything for the purpose of loving God, one another, and our city.



HISTORY

“Seek the welfare of the city where I have sent you into exile, and pray to the LORD on its behalf, for in its welfare you will find your welfare.”

Jeremiah 29:7

The story of Reality LA is a story of God’s abundant grace and faithfulness. The church was planted in 2006, and [this brief documentary video](#) traces the Lord’s goodness to the church and its role in his purposes in Los Angeles over our first ten years as a church.

Reality LA is part of the Reality family of churches, a movement committed to relational church planting. The first Reality church, Reality Carpinteria, began in 2003. Since that time, they and the other Reality churches have planted churches in Los Angeles, Stockton, Ventura, San Francisco, Santa Barbara, Boston, London, and Honolulu.

The Reality family is a church planting movement, but the goal is to plant healthy churches, not many churches. Jesus is the one who builds the church (Matthew 16:18) and is the head of the church (Colossians 1:18). It’s all about him.

SUNDAYS

Every Sunday, Reality LA gathers from all walks of life and all parts of the city. We meet in the auditorium at [Helen Bernstein High School](#) and dress the same way we dress the rest of the week. In other words, this community of faith has a lot in common with our neighbors. And we love seeing new faces!

Gatherings are about two hours. Every week, we retell the story of Jesus to re-center our lives on what matters most. This includes worshiping God through song, hearing Scripture preached, and responding with prayer, communion, and more song. Coffee or tea is available in the courtyard, along with friendly volunteers to help new attenders find their way around and assist with any questions they may have.



THE HOPE CENTER

In 2018, Reality LA inherited the people, ministries, and buildings of Hope International Bible Fellowship. Founded in 1928, Hope has a rich history of pursuing the welfare of the city and we believe this is a monumental provision from the Lord toward putting down roots in our city and catalyzing the unique vision and mission God has given us in Los Angeles.

Those buildings are now called The Hope Center and continue to be home to a robust food ministry and a residential recovery program, as well as the church offices.

Sean Johnson is the Executive Pastor and the Worship Pastor for Reality LA. He is the representative of the elders that oversees the staff and is responsible for the execution of the church's vision. POSITION SUMMARY

Reality LA is searching for a Finance Director who will report to the Executive Pastor and manage the stewardship of financial and real property resources, overseeing cash flow planning, preparing and reviewing budgets, plus tracking operational metrics. To be successful in this role, you must have in-depth knowledge of non-profit accounting, risk management methods, and the ability to create forecasting models. Ultimately, you will ensure the management of the church's resources in the most beneficial way and help maximize its funding. This includes overseeing the necessary controls for accounting and operations to protect the organization's assets, while at the same time providing a framework to achieve the vision and mission of the church.

DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

- Ensure the proper completion of the full cycle of bookkeeping and accounting duties, including asset management, deposits, disbursements, cash flow, payroll, depreciation, closing, and reconciliation.
- Interface with external auditors during annual reviews.
- Implement and enhance rigorous internal controls.
- Preparation of monthly/quarterly/annual financial documents to equip the Board of Trustees with pertinent information for decision-making.
- Develop and provide accountability for the annual budget.
- Accounts payable, accounts receivable, and vendor relations.
- Complete all quarterly and annual filings with local, state, and federal government agencies.



DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

- Reporting and maintenance of designated giving for benevolence, special projects, and campaigns.
- Manage Reality LA's savings, investments, real estate, and credit.
- Manage Finance Team Volunteers for Sunday tithing collections.
- Oversee expense management for church staff, including expense reports and receipts.
- Implement systems that support ongoing HR initiatives including a meaningful performance review system.
- Develop a robust system for tracking, reporting, and communicating financial benchmarks in building campaign and fundraising.
- Provide guidance and resources to RLA staff and congregation to minimize legal liability in a church based compassion ministry environment.
- Manage annual congregation giving statement administration.
- Other financial, corporate, insurance, or legal projects as assigned by the Executive Pastor.

STATEMENT OF FAITH
