Third Millennium Ministries (Thirdmill) is a Christian nonprofit based near Orlando, Florida (Casselberry). Founded in 1997, Thirdmill's mission is simple: *"Biblical Education. For the World. For Free."* The organization creates and distributes high-quality biblical and theological training materials—free of charge—to church leaders and students around the world.

MISSION AND IMPACT

Thirdmill exists to equip Christian leaders everywhere with solid biblical education, regardless of location, income, or language.

- Provides free video, audio, and written curriculum in 28 languages.
- Partners with seminaries, churches, and ministries to expand access to theological education.
- Over 2.1 million learners worldwide have used Thirdmill's training programs.

The Major Gift Officer (MGO) will play a key role in strengthening Thirdmill's global impact by cultivating and stewarding relationships with major donors, foundations, and ministry partners. This individual will work closely with the President and Advancement Team to expand the base of financial support that sustains Thirdmill's mission worldwide.



Key Responsibilities

- Help develop and implement an annual fundraising strategy that supports Thirdmill's mission: *"Biblical Education. For the World. For Free."*
- Establish and achieve annual giving goals, focusing on major donors, churches, and foundations.
- Build and manage a portfolio of major gift prospects, creating personalized cultivation and solicitation plans.
- Assist the Executive Leadership and the Advancement teams to design and execute fundraising initiatives aligned with ministry priorities.
- Create and maintain an annual development calendar, including campaigns, donor communications, and special events.
- Develop and implement a comprehensive stewardship program to deepen donor relationships and celebrate impact.
- Maintain accurate and current donor records in the organization's CRM.
- Collaborate with communications and global partnership teams to ensure consistent, inspiring donor messaging.
- Conduct prospect research and identify new opportunities for donor engagement.
- Plan and coordinate donor gatherings, vision events, and partner appreciation activities.
- Oversee timely gift acknowledgment and donor recognition.
- Mentor, and assist additional development staff as the department grows.
- Serve as liaison with external fundraising partners or third-party entities supporting donor engagement.
- Travel as needed (approximately 30-35%) for donor visits, church engagements, and events.

Ideal Preferred Qualifications

- Bachelor's degree required; Master's degree and/or CFRE certification a plus.
- Minimum three years of experience in fundraising, major gifts, or donor relations within a ministry, nonprofit, or educational organization.
- Proven ability to cultivate, solicit, and steward major donors.
- Experience using donor management systems (e.g., HubSpot, Salesforce, Raiser's Edge).
- Strong understanding of development best practices, including annual giving and multi-year strategies.
- Exceptional written, verbal, and presentation skills, with the ability to tell stories that inspire generosity.
- Demonstrated ability to analyze data, track outcomes, and report results clearly and effectively.
- Experience managing or mentoring staff within a development or advancement setting is a plus.

We believe in the bodily resurrection of every person for the final day of judgment before the Lord Jesus Christ — the lost unto eternal punishment and the saved unto eternal life.
